The District originally issued a request for proposal. This is a renewal contract. As part of the regular, renewal process USI reaches to incumbent and other vendors to check to see if others can provide the services at a cost that would make it reasonable to move. Based on the costs in the renewal being a slight decrease overall, there was no compelling reason to move to another vendor.

The final cost for 2024 \$3,592,074 is basically the same as 2023 \$3,680,000 due to claims data and renewal negotiation. As noted above, the total cost is directly related to the number of Benefit eligible employees.
