- How were schools chosen?
  - Schools were chosen with an equitable lens to include all of the District Wards (N, S, E, W, & C)
  - Ensuring that schools chosen had a strong leadership team that will be able to sustain and carry on the learning and the work. This first cohort will help build capacity across the district.
- Will there be a central office staff member included?
  - Joseph Cullen will be the liaison between John Hopkins and NBOE. In addition, the district has organized a district leadership team that will lead this initiative. Included on this team are the Deputy Superintendent, Assistant Superintended Dr. Mary Ann Reilly, Executive Assistant Paula Perone, Representatives from the offices of SPED, Student Life, and special assistants from each SLT.

- Discussed the Safe Plan Return Plan located on the District's Website.
- Everyone is required to wear masks.
- Contactless sites remain
- Schools have specific Safe Return Plans aligned to their school and the District's plan.
- Task Force meetings will occur as needed.
- Discussions regarding vaccination requirement are being had.
- If a class is required to quarantine due to CDC guidelines, remote learning will go in effect for that class.
- Covid tests are required for everyone (even vaccinated personal) within two weeks prior to returning to the building.
